Saskatchewan farmer wins \$5M on LOTTO 6/49!

SASKATOON (August 22, 2024) — Donald Nykiforuk admits he often won't check his lottery tickets for quite a while after he buys them.

"I really let them pile up!" the farmer joked at his prize claim interview.

Now, Nykiforuk is piling up his winnings, after a \$5 million score on the LOTTO 6/49 Classic Draw for May 8!

"I scanned the ticket on my phone app," he explained. "I [saw the win and] thought, 'Wow! I'd better figure out how to manage this!"
